INSTRUCTIONS FOR FIRST-TIME LOGIN

In partnership with Higher Logic, the gold standard in association community platforms, AVAHO is excited to launch a new interactive member platform for discussion, resources, interest groups, and more.

To access the platform from your desktop, do the following:

- Visit www.avaho.org and click on "New Member Portal" on the home screen
- This will open the new members-only site, where you will click **"login"** in the upper right corner
- This will bring up a new screen, where you will enter your email and password in the future. For the first login, please choose <u>"can't access your account"</u> (not new user) and enter the email associated with your AVAHO account. This will link you to your current membership by sending a reset email.
 - Can't remember the email associated with your account? No worries! You can create a new user account and we'll deduplicate the old. (Note: If you do this, it may erase previous membership information)
- Once you've set your password, we'll verify your membership and accept you into the community. From there, explore the site, including your own personalized news feed!




Welcome to the AVAHO Member Site!
